Our Italian Musical Heritage: 🔊



Vito Rocco Farinola..... "The Voice"....

Vito Rocco Farinola a/k/a Vic Damone was born in 1928 in the Bensonhurst neighborhood of Brooklyn, N.Y. Vito's parents came from Bari, which is in the Puglia Region of Italy. They planted roots in Bensonhurst, a mostly Italian neighborhood. His parents, both musically inclined, sent young Vito for guitar and voice lessons at an early age. After joining the choir at St. Finbar's Parish, he was a vocal standout and soon was featured on many local shows. Vito attended Lafayette High School but dropped out when his father took ill, and Vito was needed to help support the family. While ushering and operating the elevator at the famed Paramount Theatre, Perry Como took a shine to Vito and guided him in the right direction musically. At age 18, Vito Farinola now became Vic Damone, taking his Mom's maiden last name. He recorded 80 songs for MUZAK and everyone in New York who rode the elevators heard his clear baritone voice. Soon after, Vic Damone recorded his first top ten song, "I have but one heart", while being befriended by the likes of Sinatra, Como and Tommy Dorsey. He was married to a string of glamorous women including Anna Pierangeli and Diahanne Carroll. While recording for five decades, he amassed 12 charted songs as well as a star of stage and screen. Vic Damone remains retired from performing today at age 89 and is living in Florida. Sinatra said Vic had the best pipes in the business and Luciano Pavarotti called him the voice. Not bad for a Brooklyn boy.....and by the way....Vic got his high school G.E.D. diploma in 1990........

SEPT. FAMOUS ITALIAN BIRTHDAYS & HOLIDAYS

The month of settembre (September) was originally the seventh of ten months on the oldest known Roman calendar; It kept its original name from the Roman calendar in which septem means "seven" in Latin marking it as the seventh month.

September is back-to-work and back-to-school month There aren't any nationwide holidays in Italy in September, but there are several local festivals and events that are well-known.

- Venice's Regatta Storica is a day of historic gondola boat races through the Grand Canal.
- Juliet's Birthday (of Romeo and Juliet) is celebrated September 12 in Verona.
- · The Venice Film Festival is in early September.

- Sophia Loren, actress, born in Rome on the 20th of September 1934
- Marco Polo, explorer, born in Venice on the 16th of September 1254
- · Caravaggio, artist, born in Milan on the 29th of September 1571

- Andrea Bocelli, songwriter, born in Lajatico on the 22th of Sept. 1958

OCTOBER FAMOUS ITALIAN BIRTHDAYS & HOLIDAYS

The month of ottobre (October) kept its original name from the Roman calendar in which octo means "eight" in Latin marking the eighth month of the year.

In Italy, ottobre features numerous harvest- and food-related festivals:

- October is the beginning of truffle festivals throughout Italy with the biggest truffle festival, the White Truffle festival, celebrated in Alba.
- The Torrone Festival in Cremona (the birthplace of torrone, Italian nougat)
- Perugia's Euro-Chocolate which includes a collection of outdoor chocolate sculptures.
- October also begins the season of chestnut festivals with the most ancient and known chestnut is the Sagra della Castagna of Soriano, in Lazio, a few kilometers north of Rome.
- The fourth Sunday of October is celebrated as World Pasta Day.

- Ezra Pound, writer, born in Hailey, Oct. 30, 1885.




COMING SOON: 2018 IACA OFFICERS ELECTION


